# Jean Monnet Networks

=> foster the creation and development of consortia of international players (Higher Education Institutions, Centres of Excellence, departments, teams, individual experts, etc.) **in the area of European Union studies in order** to gather information, exchange practices, build knowledge and promote the European integration process across the world.

The following activities are included:

- gathering and promoting information and results on methodologies applied to high-level research and teaching on EU studies
- enhancing cooperation between different HEIs and other relevant bodies throughout Europe and around the world
- exchanging knowledge and expertise to improve good practices
- fostering cooperation and exchanges with public actors and the European Commission services on highly relevant EU subjects

The maximum eligible grant is €300,000. This can represent the maximum of 80% of the total eligible cost of the Jean Monnet Network.

# LIFE

LIFE programme is divided into two sub-programmes :

- environment (representing 75% of the overall financial envelope)
- climate action (representing 25% of the envelope)

It funds nature **conservation projects** in particular in the areas of biodiversity, habitats and species. It provides action grants for best practice, pilot and demonstration projects that contribute to the implementation of the EU's directives on birds and habitats, the EU's biodiversity strategy to 2020, and the development, implementation and management of the Natura 2000 network.

Projects receive a co-funding of up to 60%. The co-financing rate can be up to 75% if at least half of the total estimated project costs are used for actions to improve the conservation status of priority habitats or species listed in the EU's birds and habitats directives.
